A tasteful one page announcement *may be* posted on the Community Bulletin Boards by next of kin or a resident or a person they designate without specific BOD approval. Further, if any resident or unit owner will provide appropriate details which can be used in a card or letter the BOD would be proud to communicate the community's respect and affection to a grieving family or a departing resident. We do not have sufficient data on all residents to do so without assistance, and we want to treat all members of the community equally – and with respect and dignity.
